We hope that you are all excited as we are for MUCKED UP TAILS Chapter 7- World Tour!! There are a few things that we need to let you know about before your arrival on Friday the 22nd of July.

What to bring:

There is a packing list attached that you can use as a guide. Remember to tick off items as you pack them to make sure that you don't forget anything!

Costume:

Come along dressed as something travel related (It may include dressing up as a tourist or wearing or a costume inspired by a particular country). Remember that there is a PRIZE for the scout with the most creative costume IN THE WORLD!!!

Costumes are to be worn on Saturday.

How to get there:

Rowallan Scout Camp, 6 Kent Rd, Riddells Creek

From Kilmore Rd, turn onto Mount Charlie Rd which continues along to become Kent Rd.

Enter Gate 4.

Arrival:

Scout arrival time from 7:00pm to 9:00pm on Friday the 22nd of July.

Enter at Gate 4, you will be greeted by our committee and have your names checked off before being directed to your campsite. Scouts will not be fed any dinner on Friday night, because of this, it is required for the scouts to have their own dinner prior to arriving at the camp.

Any medication will need to be taken to the registration shed which will be set up near the scout campsite.

If you are arriving outside of the registration period (7:00 - 9:00pm) on Friday, please proceed directly to Warnock Lodge / Parade Ground and make yourself known to a committee member (Look for someone in an orange vest with 'COMMITTEE' on the back). If you intend to arrive outside this period, please let us know ahead of time.

Scout departure will be at 2:30pm on Sunday the 24th of July (parade will be at 2:00) please enter through Gate 2.

Uniforms must be worn for arrival and departure.

Early departure:

If you need to leave camp at any time. Please email us beforehand, and see the first aider prior to departure.

Operoo/PIR:

Please ensure that you have completed your Operoo profile before the camp.

Covid requirements:

It is recommended that everyone completes a RAT 24 hours prior to arrival. If you do test positive, email us for a full refund.

A Google Form will be sent 48 hours prior to the camp, this must be completed to ensure that Coronavirus does not spread within the camp in order to protect everyone.
