What to bring:

Costumes are to be worn on Saturday.

How to get there:

Rowallan Scout Camp, 6 Kent Rd, Riddells Creek

From Kilmore Rd, turn onto Mount Charlie Rd which continues along to become Kent Rd.

Enter Gate 4.

Arrival:

Scout's arrival time is from 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm on Friday the 8th of August.

At Gate 4, you will be greeted by our committee:

- Your names will be checked off at the gate before being directed to your campsite.
- Any medication will need to be taken by First Aid next to the scout camping area. Please ensure it is clearly labelled with the Scout's name and dosages required.
- Make sure you have a copy of your [Trybooking QR code](#) downloaded on your phone or printed out.

Friday night dinner is not provided to Scouts so they are required to have their dinner before arriving at the camp.

If you are arriving outside the registration period (7:00 - 9:00 pm) on Friday, please proceed directly to Warnock Lodge / Parade Ground and make yourself known to a committee member (Look for someone in an orange vest with 'COMMITTEE' on the back). If you intend to arrive outside this period, please let us know ahead of time by emailing us at

Departure:

Scout departure will be at 2:30 pm on Sunday the 10th of August (parade will be at 2:00) please enter through Gate 4.

Uniforms must be worn for arrival and departure.

Early departure:
